Note from our Art Director

The Creative Arts and Restorative Education Program, C.A.R.E., consists of mural projects, social-emotional student groups, and extracurricular arts programs at Julia de Burgos Elementary School in North Philadelphia. For the past four months 2nd through 8th-grade students participating in the C.A.R.E. program have worked to create all the sensory objects for this production and illustrate the storybook. Throughout this process, students learned printmaking, papermaking, and many different fiber arts. For the sun, moon, and snow objects students learned how to sew, embroider, and crochet. For the leaf and spring objects, students learned printmaking techniques such as etching and batiking as well as learning how to make recycled paper. Students were also able to develop their painting and drawing skills through the painting of the shakers and fans, the illustrating of the storybook, and the painting of the canvas bags in which the sensory objects are held. Our students are so excited to see their creations in action and we are so proud of their creativity and perseverance throughout this project.
